Twenty second Sunday of the Year (A) – 31 August 2008

First Reading (Jeremiah 20:7-9). The prophet Jeremiah pours out his pain and anger to God as he experiences the difficulties of his prophetic calling.

Second Reading (Romans 12:1-12). Paul instructs us on the right kind of worship we should offer to God. It is the offering of our daily life as a sacrifice to him.

Gospel (Matthew 16:21-27). For the first time, Jesus predicts his passion to his disciples, and he tells them that they also must learn to take up the Cross if they are to be faithful disciples.
